

Global 2000 and other CACOR initiatives

The Canadian Association for the Club of Rome catalyzed the funding by the Canadian Government of the Montebello Meeting of the Club of Rome at which the Meadows' *Limits to Growth* (Meadows. Universe Books, 1972) proposals were presented; also the financing of the travel of world experts in the course of the preparation of *Beyond the Age of Waste* (by Gabor, Colombo, King and Galli), and a South American study *Catastrophe or New Society - A Latin American Model* which was ultimately published by the International Development Research Centre. In addition to these examples, following the report *Global-2000* to the President of the United States, the Canadian Association sponsored the publication of *Global-2000 – Implications for Canada* (Barney et. al., Pergamon, 1980). The studies behind these Canadian publications were mostly funded directly by the Canadian Government but the initiative for them came from the Canadian Association for the Club of Rome.
